Welcome to the second instalment of the Primary 2 newsletter. Our second term has already crept up on us so quickly as time is flying by this year. We all hope you had an enjoyable and restful October break, allowing for some time to recharge and be ready for learning upon return.

Literacy

Writing - In writing we will continue to use a 'Talk for Writing' approach. We will be doing a block of imaginative writing this term. We are continuing to make sure our letters are formed properly, on the lines and are the appropriate size. We are also remembering to use capital letters and full stops.

Phonics - We are carrying on our final blends, including end blends (e.g. nk, ng, rk, It) and consonant blends at the start of words (e.g. bl, cl, sw, sm). We are going to move onto Magic e (e.g. same, came, home, tone). We will also be focusing on the introduction/consolidation of tricky words to support the development of sight recognition of key words when reading.

Reading - Please remember to hand in your Red Reading Book Bag on a Friday so that the reading books can be added in to go home on Monday.

Listening and Talking - We will continue to have Circle Time which allows learners to share something they may be enjoying at school or at home. During Circle Time we practise being respectful to one another with good listening skills.

Health and Wellbeing

This term we are covering Looking after Plants and Animals. We will also be covering People who help me and look after me as part of our RSHP series of lessons. We will be looking at:

In Maths we will look at Handling Data. We will work on interpreting data and using it to answer questions and gain greater understanding of information.

Throughout this term there are many seasonal elements to be learning about. We will cover Halloween, Bonfire Nights and Firework Safety, Festivals of Light such as Diwali, Hannukkah and Christmas, These will al provide rich contexts for learning and many opportunities for writing, drama, arts and crafts.
